Britannia Secondary's Graduation (School Leaving) Ceremony, for the Graduating class of 2018 is planned for Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. We are anticipating a memorable evening to honour the class of 2018 and their many achievements. Please read the information on the back of this letter detailing the events of June 12<sup>th</sup>. We appreciate your assistance in ensuring that your son or daughter is where he or she needs to be that day and on time. Students will be given this same information from their counsellor in class but, as we all know, this is a very busy time of year and reminders are helpful and necessary.

Grade 12 students participating in the ceremony do not need a ticket. Two complimentary tickets will be given to each grade 12 student for family members. Students must pick up these tickets at the Grade 12 assembly scheduled for Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm. A limited number of additional tickets may be purchased for \$7 if the student plans to invite more than two guests. Tickets will be available for purchase on Thursday, May 24<sup>th</sup> and Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup> outside of room 305 at lunchtime.

The Ceremony will be held at the Italian Cultural Centre, and doors will open for family and friends at 5:00pm, the ceremony will begin promptly at 5:30pm. Seating is available on a "first-come, first-served" basis. This formal ceremony lasts approximately 2 hours and is most suitable for adults and children over eight years of age.

Graduates need to arrive at the Italian Cultural Center at 4:30pm.

Graduates participating in the ceremony must attend the June 11<sup>th</sup> 2:00pm rehearsal in the Britannia auditorium, the day before the ceremony. Attending the rehearsal is mandatory. If the Graduate is wearing new shoes or heels, we recommend they bring them to the rehearsal so they can practice the processional and walking up the stairs to the stage.
