Preliminary Course Selection

Indicate below the program (Diploma or Partial) that you are interested in pursuing. Also indicate the courses that you expect to take if you are accepted. This information will assist us in tentative course scheduling. You may alter your choices when you do your final course planning.

The primary goal of the IB Program is the IB Diploma. Therefore, candidates desiring the Diploma Program will be given first priority in the selection process. Partial Program students will be accommodated where class-size permits.

All candidates should be aware of the following requirements and restrictions:

Diploma Program

- the Theory of Knowledge course is required
- three Higher Level courses and three Standard Level courses are required
- one subject from each Group is required

Partial Program

- enrolment in the Theory of Knowledge is limited to Diploma candidates
- you are limited to a maximum of four courses (if you desire more IB courses than a full Diploma Program is recommended)
- it is preferred that students take more than one course for the Partial Program and that they take the Higher Level of the course where it is possible

Note 1: Students who intend to study Sciences at university must have credit for Physics 11, Chemistry 11, a science at the grade 12 level, and Principles of Math 12 (min. 67%). Be sure to consult with your counselor before making your final course selection. If you intend to take IB Biology and/or IB Chemistry but would also need to take regular Physics 11 as your eighth course indicate this below (at the **) so that we may timetable appropriately. You may also consider taking Physics 11 at a Completion Summer School. IB courses, except for IB English are equivalent to the corresponding Ministry course.
